### WWS Tuition Management and Parent Contributions Policy 2012-2013 School Year

#### Tuition Management Policy

It is an obligation to pay the tuition and fees for the full academic year and this obligation is unconditional. **After July 1, 2012, no portion of tuition or fees paid or outstanding will be refunded in the event of absence, withdrawal, or dismissal, except for students who are (a) provisionally accepted or (b) partially insured under the Tuition Insurance Plan. The family is financially responsible for the student(s) and legally obligated to pay the full tuition amount.**

#### Payment Plans

The balance of tuition, net of the Deposit and the Tuition Insurance Plan, is payable in **1 single, 2, 4** or up to **10 equal payments** depending on when the family signs up for FACTS. Ten payments are available for the July 20<sup>th</sup> start date, Nine for August 20<sup>th</sup>, Eight for payments beginning September 20<sup>th</sup> and so on. The payments are due via FACTS on the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month.

#### Deposit(s)

Deposit(s) for returning students are payable on or before **January 20, 2012**. For new students, deposits are due on the due date stated on the acceptance letter. If you are applying for Tuition Assistance, your Deposit is not due until you are notified and accept the award extended. Without timely payment, space cannot be guaranteed. **Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.**

#### Tuition Insurance Plan (TIP)

In the event that the child is withdrawn from school after the contract is executed, parents who have elected TIP are eligible for a 50% Liability release of the tuition related to unattended school days. The Tuition Insurance Plan must be paid in full with the deposit. **TIP is non-refundable and non-transferable.**

#### Tuition Assistance (TA)

TA is available for ALL new and re-enrolling Kindergarten and Grades 1-8 families; All interested families must complete the application process in its entirety via [www.factstuitionaid.com](http://www.factstuitionaid.com) by the posted deadline.

#### Parent Contribution

As with all other independent and private schools, tuition alone provides insufficient revenue to cover operating costs. In order to keep the School vibrant and to help Westside Waldorf School to grow each family is expected to

1. contribute to the Annual Giving Campaign
2. contribute 50 volunteer hours to community events, such as festivals, fundraisers, class activities, committee work

#### Opportunities for Education and Community Development

In order to enhance a family's understanding of the aims of Waldorf Education each family is expected to

1. Attend at least two lectures or workshops on Waldorf Education per year
2. Attend class parent meetings
3. Attend parent/teacher conferences
4. Read the school communications sent out via e-mail on weekends

#### The Importance of Being on Time

A child experiences the world as stable and safe when basic daily rhythms can be counted on, such as the daily warmth of food, the kindness in social interaction and being on time to school. In order to enhance stress-free daily rhythms, Westside's teachers expect that

1. a child arrives on time in the mornings (children may not be dropped off more than 15 minutes prior to the designated class starting time)
2. a child can count on prompt pick-up at the designated or arranged times (children are to be picked up within 15 minutes of the designated pick-up time)
